## RULES

This is a catch and release competition and all entrants must take a photo of their catch with the competition card visible. You must bring a memory card or download cable for us to be able to view the images on a laptop, the registration card will be the 1<sup>st</sup> picture to be seen on your card. In the event of a draw a points system will be put in place to decide the winner.

Rods in at 9.30am and final checking in at 4.00pm

All entrants must fish off a kayak

A maximum of 2 rods and 6 hooks at any one time can be used

Only 1 person per kayak (tandem kayaks 1 person on board)

Fishing can only take place within the designated areas , anyone caught outside will be disqualified

All fish must be caught with a rod and line and a photo taken with hook still in place and card visible

All entrants must be aged 18 and over

All entrants must have a vhf radio or mobile phone

All entrants must wear a pfd at all times during the competition

All forms must be completed and signed before you can compete

All entrants must abide by the rules and decisions of the marshals and committee

All entrants must have in place a minimum of 3<sup>rd</sup> party liability insurance

All entrants must sign back in

The judges decision is final and any complaints and or protests must be put in writing to the committee no later than 5.00 pm on the day of the competition.

In the event of bad weather the competition will go ahead on the Sunday weather pending, if not all money paid will be refunded on the Sunday
